

# SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

## STORM SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Remain calm
- Fasten and consolidate any material to the ground (caravans, awning, tents, ustensils ...)
- Take down any overhead installations
- Cut off gas and electricity
- Ask the head of the site where the safest shelter can be found
- Help evacuate your family using the itinerary indicated by the manager of the camp site.

## FLOOD SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

In the event of an announcement made by the security and civil protection services of a rise in the water level due to torrentiel rain, although unlike, a rather quick or slow flood could occur on part or all of the camp site.

The alert will be given long enough in advance so that all the campers may be forewarned of the rise in the water level. This information will be conveyed by public adress.

If such an incident should occur, follow carefully the instructions given to you.

- ▶ Move away from any danger by going up to the highest levels in the vicinity or to the meeting point indicated on the enclosed map.
- ▶ DO NOT BACKTRACK
- ▶ Inform of your presence if you are isolated so that our emergency teams may locate you.
- ▶ Remain calm
- ▶ Take some identification with you while heading to the emergency exits indicated by arrows.
- ▶ In the area named 'rapidly submersible', it is forbidden to set up canvas tents, caravans or vehicles
- ▶ Help evacuate your family using the itinerary indicated by the manager of the camp site.

## FOR FIRE PREVENTION :

- Do not smoke in any area where smoking is prohibited, as indicated by signs
- Beware of inflammable products
- Do not modify heating lighting apparatus or electrical installations
- Do no use open flame sources :  
Barbecues with open flame are prohibited except in areas specially fitted for the purpose

## IN CASE OF EMERGENCY :

- Locate the exits and paths leading to them
- Read and follow the instructions relating to extinguishers
- Always ensure that the exits are accessible
- Do not park your car on lanes reserved for the fire-brigade vehicles
- Park your caravan in direction of departure

## IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE

- Remain calm
- Cut off the energy meters (gas, electricity, etc ...)
- Try to put out the fire by using the appropriate means, attacking the flames from the bottom upwards.
- Help evacuate your family using the itinerary indicated by the manager of the campside
- If your should hear the fire alarm, evacuate the endangered area.
